We receive our General Fund money from several different places: taxes, asset sales, special assessments, fees & services, intergovernmental, licenses, permits and more.


The numbers below show where that money is budgeted to be spent.

*(police, fire, EMS, crime prevention, flood control, animal control, etc.)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ %  **Public Works**  
*(roads, bridges and sidewalk maintenance, snow removal, street cleaning, etc.)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ %  **Health & Social Services**  
*(city hospitals, health regulation and inspection, water/air/mosquito control, etc.)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ %  **Culture & Recreation**  
*(library, museum/band/theater, parks, recreation, cemetery, community center, etc.)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ %  **Community & Economic Development**  
*(beautification, economic development, housing and urban renewal, planning and zoning, etc.)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ %  **General Government**  
*(mayor/council/city manager, clerk/treasurer/finance administrator, elections, legal services & city attorney, city hall and general buildings, tort liability, etc.)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ %  **Debt Service**  
*(government capital projects, TIF capital projects)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ %  **Capital Projects**
- \_\_\_\_\_ %  **Transfers Out**  
*(to funds other than General Fund)*
